- Anyone
- Everyone

What information do you need to report?

- Basic Demographic Information
 - Name, Age, Date of Birth, Location
- Is the adult disabled?
- Are they currently utilizing services?
- Description of alleged maltreatment?
 - Abuse
 - Caretaker Neglect
 - Self-Neglect
 - Exploitation


The APS Process

- Intake
 - -Screen In
 - -Screen out- (Outreach and Referrals)
- Evaluation
- Case Decision
- Capacity
- Obtain Authorization
- Planning and Mobilization
- Reassess
- Terminate
